Mrs. Bale's Algebra 1 classes

If your student **has access to the internet** then they are to continue to work on [ALEKS](#). ALEKS has videos, lessons, examples and references to their textbook for each topic. ALEKS also works on their smart phone. They have online access to their textbook using their [clever](#) account. Students can send questions to me on ALEKS and I can see the problem they are working on. I eliminated chapters 8 and 9 for right now. Please have your student work through chapters 1 through 7 plus the statistics in chapter 11. Most of those topics have already been taught in class they just need to practice and reinforce these skills so that when we do return there is less of a need to review past topics. At the end of the 3rd nine weeks students should have been between 70% and 75% mastery on ALEKS.

If your student **does not have access to internet** then they were instructed to take home their Algebra journal and sign out a text book. They are to make sure they understand chapters 1 through 7. Most of these lessons have been taught, they need to practice working the problems. They do not need to do every problem, they just need to do enough that they understand the concept. If they understand the lesson then they can move on to the next section. I am working on making an answer sheet for the practice problems in that journal so your student can check their work.
