Homework for this break from school:

Each week WATCH one movie. Create careful notes and return them to the school for grading.

Your notes must include the following:

Movie Title. Be sure to underline the title.

Names of the main characters in the movie and the actors' actual names for the main characters.

Setting: *where* and *when* did the action of the movie supposedly happen.

Type of movie: historical or historical fiction, or science fiction, romance, famous tragedy, dystopian – perfectly planned society gone wrong or end of the world due to mass extinction, Western, comedy, superhero, cartoon, musical, or fantasy.

Write in your own words, not a copy of a movie critic's words, a 100 words or more summary of the movie. All spelling must be correct. Use no contractions, unless in a quote from the movie. Do not address this teacher with the pronoun YOU in this summary.
