Objectives:

Students will use technology to create multi-media content. Students will use both music and video to create content. The main objective is to keep students engaged with music, and to keep them creating unique and musical content.

Assignment 1/Week One Part 1: March 16, 17; due March 20

Create video/multi-media content using Beethoven's 5th Symphony about choir. At least 30 seconds in length.

Assignment 2/Week One Part 2: March 18, 19; due March 23

Create video/multi-media content, at least 20 seconds in length, using a song from a Broadway Musical, about proper hand-washing techniques.

Assignment 3/ Week Two Part 1: March 23, 24; Due March 25

Create video/multi-media content of at least 30 seconds in length: students are to write their own rap about what they do on a day that school is canceled and how they occupy their time.

Assignment 4/Week Two Part 2: March 25, 26; Due March 27

Create video/multi-media content of at least 30 seconds in length: students are to make a video describing their best friend and how much they miss them when they do not have school.
