By **combining sentences**, we can take two or more short, plain sentences and turn them into one longer, more detailed sentence. Using clauses and modifiers can also help to enhance your writing in new ways!

## Here is an example:

Sentence 1: I applied for a job at the mall.

Sentence 2: They called me the very next day to set up an interview.

**Combined Sentence**: I applied for a job at the mall, and the very next day I was called to set up an interview.

Notice these two sentences were combined into one sentence by using a comma and the conjunction *and*.

We can make the sentence sound even better by adding even more to enhance the sentence:

I applied for a job at the mall, and to my surprise, the very next day the called me to set up an interview.

Since I need to start saving for college, I applied for a job at the mall, and I was surprised and elated that the very next day I was called to set up an interview.

## Here is another example, using 3 sentences:

Sentence 1: The doctor attended to the patient.

Sentence 2: The patient's leg was broken.

Sentence 3: The doctor was confident that the patient would recover quickly.

**Combined Sentence**: The doctor examined the patient's broken leg, and was confident that with good care, the leg would heal quickly, and the patient would be walking on his own within just a few months.

Notice that you can rearrange the sentences, and add or remove as much as you want in order for the combined sentence to make sense and sound good to your ears.

By combining sentences, we can avoid what might be considered short, dull, or repetitive sentences, and instead, write sentences that are worthy of the great writer you are becoming!
